### AltTox Forums: A How To

One of the more innovative features of AltTox.org is its set of interactive forums dedicated to specific topics within the broader field of non-animal methods of toxicity testing. The forums enable stakeholders to exchange information and perspectives on types of toxicities and technologies, as well as government programs and policies and overarching challenges and opportunities. The forums serve partly as bulletin boards for alerting readers to some development (e.g., the availability of conference proceedings) and partly as discussion platforms for posting questions or perspectives and calling for feedback.

However, many people are unfamiliar with posting messages on online forums. To address this problem, the AltTox Management Team has drafted the following step-by-step instructions. Note: you do not need to register or log into the forums if you simply want to browse the forums and read postings.

- Go to the forum home page by entering <http://forums.alttox.org> into your web browser, or by clicking on "Enter Forums" in the AltTox Forums area of the AltTox home page, or simply click [here](#)
- Near the top of the AltTox Forum page click on "Register"
- Complete the registration form, check "I Accept", and hit the Register button at the bottom of page (keep a record of your user name and password)
- Click on the forum you want to post a comment to
- To start your own message thread, hit "New Topic"
- To read and reply to existing message threads, click on any of the listed message titles. Select the "Reply" button to add your comment
- To receive notifications of new topics on one or more of the forums, enter the forum(s) and hit the "Notify" button. To receive notifications of replies to specific topics within a forum, you must be within the message to hit the "Notify" button
- Browse other forum buttons for additional functions

Registration is required only once; on return visits you simply log in with your user name and password or choose "Forever" next to the password field (if you are using the same computer).
